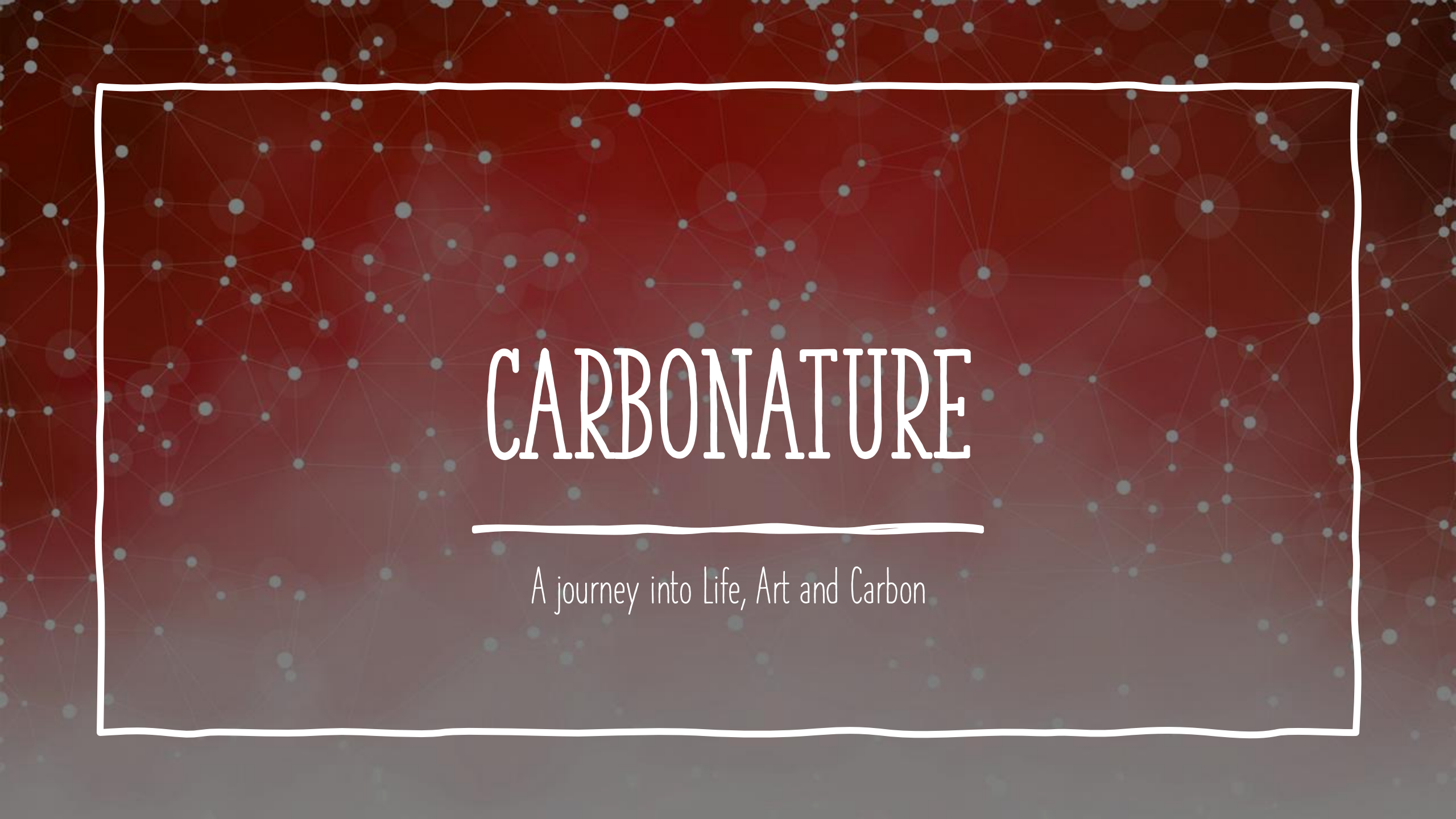
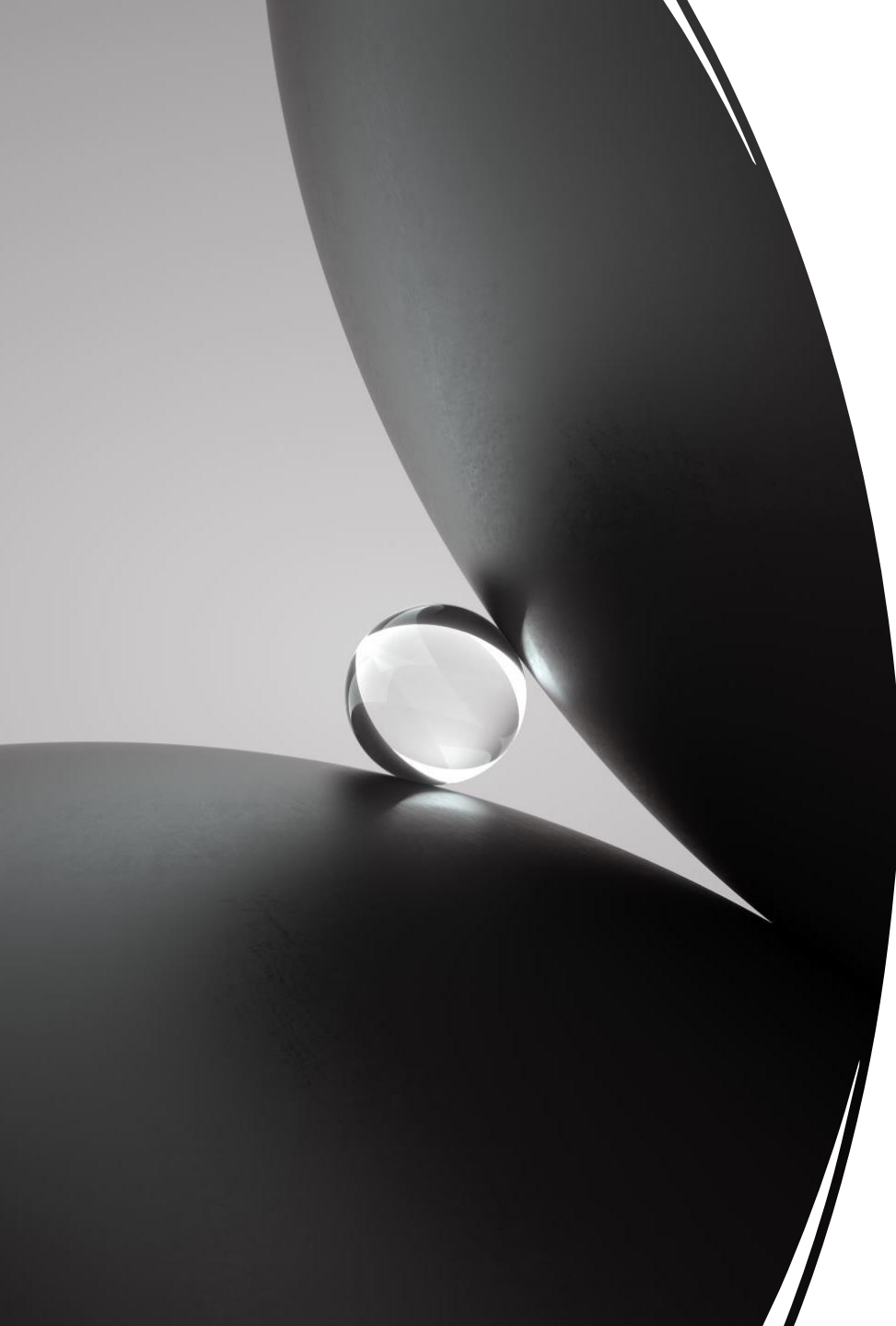

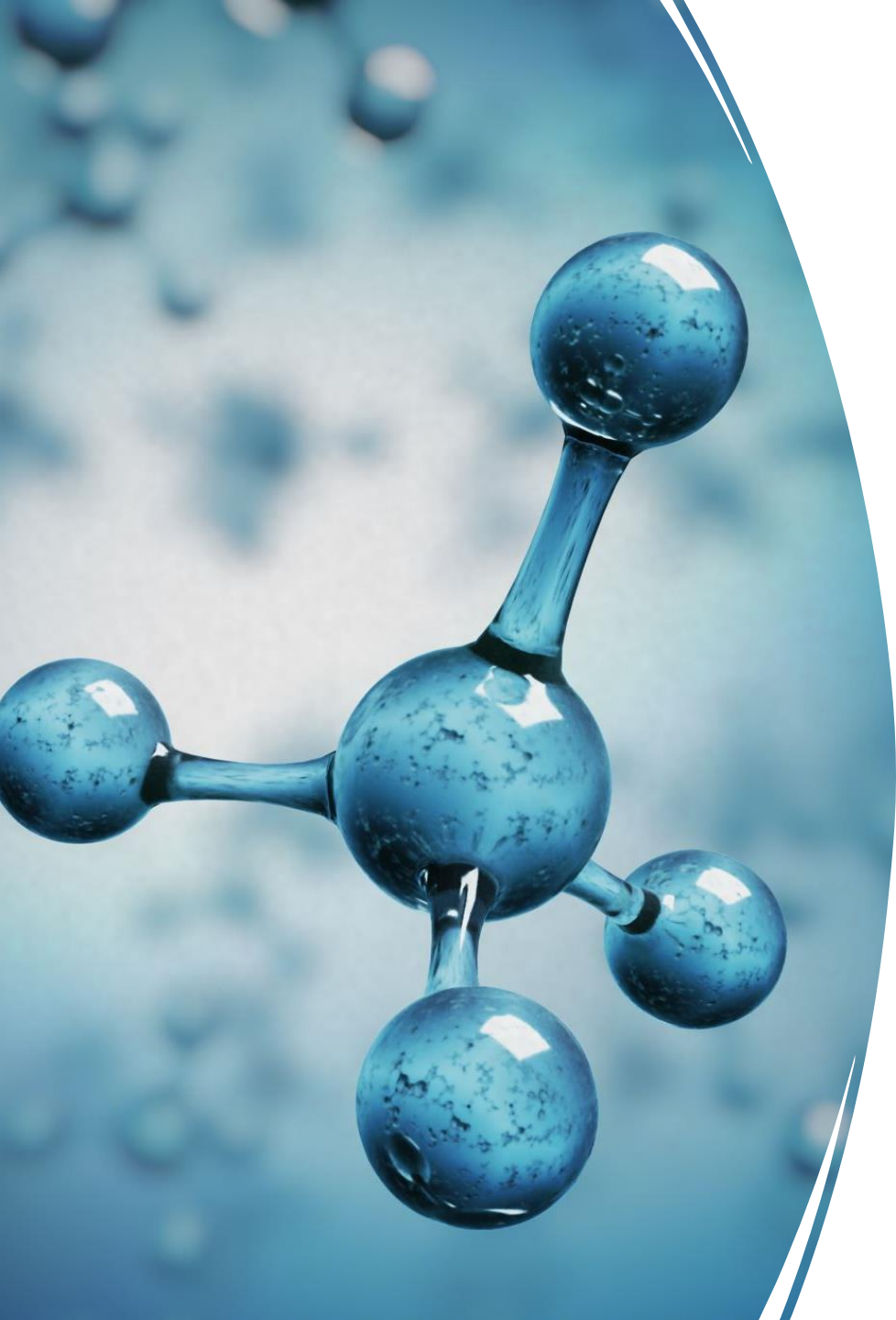
A journey into Life, Art and Carbon



WHAT IS CARBONATURE

Carbonature is a unique art and educational movement developed by Kim Perrier that connects the science of carbon with creativity and life.

It fosters awareness of our shared carbon identity through sculpture, education, and environmental philosophy.



THE CORE PHILOSOPHY - IT

- “IT” symbolizes everything that is carbon – linking the molecular, biological, and spiritual elements of life.
- LIFE = Light, Identity, Form, Energy.
- This philosophy reflects our deep interconnectedness through the shared essence of carbon.



THE SCULPTURAL PROCESS

- **Using medical-grade plaster gauze, a mold of the face is made and filled with charcoal or recycled material. The result is a unique portrait symbolizing transformation and identity.**



THE SCULPTURAL PROCESS

- Charcoal harvested from the bush is ground in a mulcher, mixed with a waterproof PVA Glue and a thick layer is placed inside the mold.
- Once cured the charcoal sculpture is ready for installation onto tree, wall or what ever background.
The sculpture or mask could also be hung on a wall.



THE SCULPTURAL PROCESS

- The student or individual fills the mask with charcaol prior to attaching to surface.
The mask or human sculpture is then pushed firmly onto the surface and secured with stainless steel or galvanised wood screws.

COMMUNITY IN ACTION



- **Carbonature workshops are inclusive and therapeutic, involving people of all ages. They encourage connection, healing, and meaningful discussions around life and nature.**

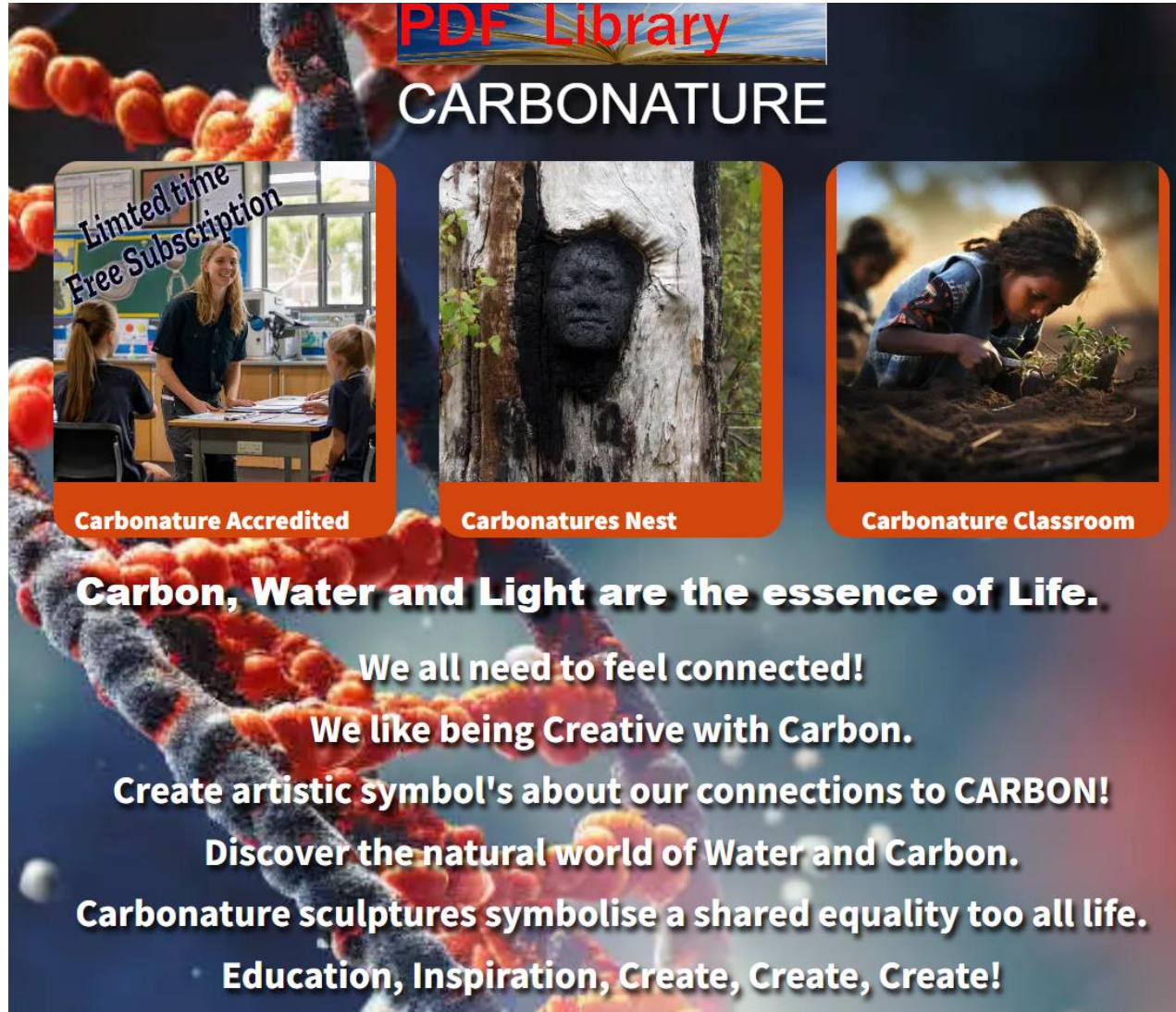


NATURE AND MEMORY

- Carbonature integrates with the natural world.
